WHEREAS, the Mayor has recommended the clothing allowance for the year fiscal year 2025.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of Waynesfield, County of Auglaize, State of Ohio

Section 1. The following shall be the annual allowance of clothing and uniforms for each position listed below. This allowance will be prorated on September 1, 2024 and thereon after allowance will be paid out on the first payroll of the year, starting January 1, 2025.

Full-time Maintenance: \$500.00  
Part-time Maintenance: \$250.00  
Administrator: \$500.00

Section 2. It is found that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council that resulted in this formal action were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code, and the Rules of Council.

ORDINANCE 2024-6-3

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE 23-10-6 TO AMEND THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Waynesfield, Ohio has reviewed the Annual Appropriations Ordinance and has determined it is necessary to amend certain fund account totals to reflect the actual amounts to be appropriated.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Waynesfield, Ohio:

Section 1: The Annual Appropriations Ordinance Number 2023-10-6 in the amount of \$3,225,212.68, which provides appropriations for the fiscal year ending December 31, 2024, will be amended to reflect the following changes in order to meet current expenses and to authorize certain other expenditures:

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SECTION 2. Existing Ordinance 2023-10-06 is hereby amended and restated.

SECTION 3. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to make payments from any of the appropriations herein made, upon receiving proper claims, certificates and / or vouchers approved by the officials, department heads, or their respective designees, authorized by law to approve the same, or upon an ordinance or resolution of Council to make expenditures; provided, however, that no payments for salaries or wages shall be made except to persons employed in accordance with the ordinances of the Village of Waynesfield and / or laws of the State of Ohio.

SECTION 4. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to adjust appropriations within any fund or department, so long as the adjustments made do not exceed the total appropriations authorized within any fund or department. In addition, the Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to establish additional accounts within any fund as may from time to time be required to ensure proper accounting or by the State of Ohio.

SECTION 5. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public and in compliance with all legal requirements.

Section 3: This ordinance is declared to be an emergency and therefore take effect and be in full force immediately upon its passage and approval.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF WAYNESFIELD, OHIO TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH DANIEL L. BEY, REMINGER CO., L.P.A., FOR SERVICES OF INTERIM VILLAGE SOLICITOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Waynesfield, Ohio:

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Council wishes to appoint an interim Village Solicitor through contract on a three (3) month basis;

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Waynesfield wishes to appoint through contract, as an independent contractor, Daniel L. Bey, Reminger Co., L.P.A., as interim Village Solicitor;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Council of the Village of Waynesfield, Ohio:

**SECTION I:** The Mayor is authorized to enter into an agreement with Daniel L. Bey, Reminger Co., L.P.A., to perform the duties of the Village Solicitor as an independent contractor. The Mayor is further authorized to execute any and all documents in connection with said agreement.

**SECTION II:** That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this council and that all deliberations of this Council, and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION III:** This Ordinance is hereby found to be an emergency necessary for the public welfare because the Village administration requires uninterrupted legal representation and services for ongoing and future matters to provide the services necessary to the general public health, safety, and welfare. It shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon passage.
