WHEREAS, the Council has determined that the Waynesfield Police Department is capable of providing such services as outlined in the Memorandum of Understanding signed by the village and school district, and

WHEREAS, the Council believes this agreement will only enhance the safety and security at the school and in the village.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of Waynesfield, County of Auglaize, State of Ohio, to approve the agreement for part-time school resource officer services between the Village of Waynesfield and the Waynesfield-Goshen Local School District for the 2026-2027 school year.

RESOLUTION NO 26-6-2

**AN RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT THE PASSAGE OF THE STOP CSAM ACT, AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY FOR THE VILLAGE OF WAYNESFIELD, OHIO**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Waynesfield Council believes that protecting our children is imperative; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Waynesfield Council believes that child sexual abuse material should never be disseminated, created, or sold; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Waynesfield Council recognizes that the nation's technology companies should utilize their resources to stop child sexual abuse material and take tangible steps towards helping ending child sexual exploitation, human trafficking, and child pornography from being allowed on all digital platforms; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Waynesfield believes that online sexual exploitation of all people, especially children, should never be allowed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Waynesfield believes that any and all reasonable steps should be taken to proactively prevent child sexual abuse material from being stored, shared, and sold online or in person; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Waynesfield believes that the passage of the Stop CSAM Act will go a long way towards accountability in the technology sector, protecting victims, and even preventing future victims.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the Village of Waynesfield, County of Auglaize, State of Ohio, a majority of its elected members concurring:

Congress is strongly encouraged to pass the Stop CSAM Act of 2025 (House of Representative Bill 3921; Senate Bill 1829) in the most expeditious and efficient way possible. Congress should affirmatively pass the Stop CSAM Act of 2025 in order to protect children across the globe and hold accountable those that are responsible for child sexual abuse material, child exploitation, and human trafficking.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution shall be in force and take effect from the earliest period allowed by law.
